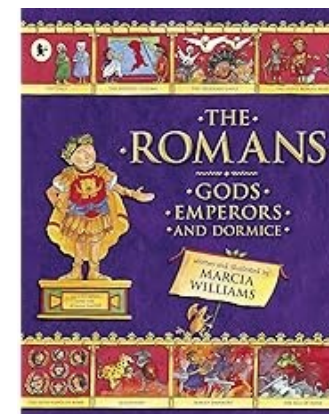

Diamond — Term 2

English	This term in English, the children will be exploring their new book, 'The Romans: Gods, Emperors and Dormice' by Marcia Williams. They will be learning to create non-chronological reports and will be able to identify features of this non-fiction text confidently. We will discuss the illustrations and how these support the children's learning.
Maths	The children will be continuing to develop their number, problem solving and reasoning skills in maths this term through learning about area, multiplication and division. This will include different times tables and corresponding division facts.
Science	This term in Science, the children will be beginning a new topic: 'States of Matter.' They will compare and group materials, identifying solids, liquids and gases. They will observe changes when materials are heated or cooled and understand the terms evaporation and condensation.
History	In History this term, the children will be learning about The Romans. The children will learn about the Roman Empire, how they invaded Britain and the changes that this brought about. The children will then be thinking about the factors which caused the fall of the Roman Empire.
Art/DT	In DT this term, the children will be looking at 'Electrical systems: Torches.' The children will use their knowledge of electrical circuits from last term and revise key vocabulary to think about how a torch works. They will use this knowledge to design and make their own functioning torch.
PSHE	The children will be learning about safety and the changing body. The children will be learning about Internet safety and how search engines work. They will also learn about first aid for somebody suffering from an asthma attack, as well as the risks of smoking.
Computing	The children will be continuing to develop their Computing skills by learning about Online Safety. This will include learning about spam emails and how to respond to these, the dangers of identity theft, healthy screen time and what plagiarism is.
RE	In R.E, the children will be exploring the Christianity topic of 'What is the Trinity?' by looking at examples of the Bible and what this shows that Christians believe about God. From this, the children will begin to formulate their own opinions of what they believe.
PE	This term in P.E, the children will be exploring Challenge Games and Netball. They will be continuing to work on their balance, coordination and agility within these sessions. They will be using different techniques to develop the way they pass the ball. This term the children will be focusing on team work and team building activities alongside this.
