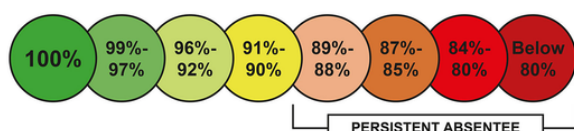
DOJO SHOP
