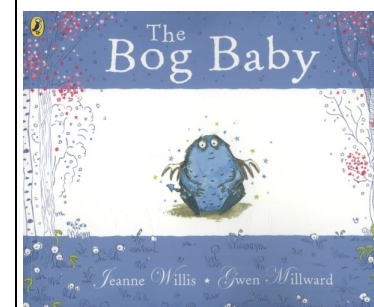

Topaz—Term 3	English	This term in English, the children will be exploring their new book 'The Bog Baby' by Jeanne Willis. They will be using our senses to describe and write a setting description of the bluebell forest. The children will not know how the story ends and so will write a narrative to finish the ending of the story themselves.
	Maths	To begin with, we will be looking at 2D and 3D shapes and how these can be grouped and sorted. We will then move onto place value within 20, where we will be looking at numbers 11-20. We will learn how to count up to 20 confidently, how to order them and explore 1 more and one less. We will also start addition and subtraction within 20 too.
	Science	This term in Science, the children will be beginning a new topic: 'Animals including humans - Our Pets'. They will be exploring and making observations about different animal habitats and how to group different types of animals. They will also be learning about how to look after a pet and be able to identify that the pet is happy and healthy.
	History	In history this term, we will be looking at changes within the living memory—travel and transport. We will be looking at a timeline of how transportation has changed overtime and how this has had a positive impact on people's lives, opening up a range of different opportunities. We will also look at the similarities and differences between different modes of transport.
	Art/DT	In art this term, the children will explore using paint and mixed media. They will look at the primary colours, be able to name them and then will experiment with the primary colours to make secondary colours. By the end of the unit, the children should be able to name the secondary colours and explain which two primary colours are used to make the secondary colour.
	Music	The children will be looking at musical vocabulary this term. They will be exposed to the pulse, tempo, dynamics, timbre, pitch and rhythm in order to evaluate and compose a piece of music.
	Computing	The children will be continuing to develop their computing skills by using computers and iPads to create an animated story book. They will be able to insert text and pictures to bring their book to life.
	RE	In R.E, the children will be exploring the Gospel and focusing on the big question 'What is the good news that Jesus brings?' We will be looking stories from the bible and recognise a link with a concept of 'Gospel' or good news. The children will also explore how Christians follow the teachings studied about forgiveness and peace and how Christians put these into practice.
	PE	This term in P.E, the children will be learning to use a range of different equipment during gymnastics with Miss Bracken. They will be continuing to work on balance and coordination, both individually and with others.
