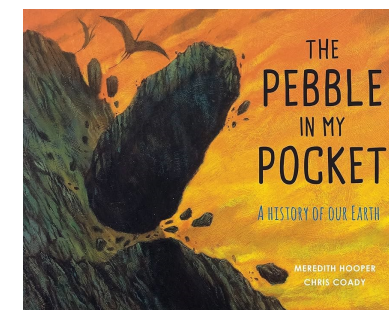

Ruby—Term 4

English	This term in English, we will be exploring our new class text 'Pebble in my pocket' by Meredith Hooper. We will write a story narrative of the journey of a pebble from its origins to its new position. We will be exploring the text closely in Destination Reader, making connections to our previous science topic on rocks and clarifying the meaning of vocabulary.
Maths	This term we will continue the topic of multiplication and division. We will be learning how to multiply 2 digit numbers by 1 digit numbers both with and without exchanging as well as learning how to divide numbers with remainders. Then we will move onto exploring length and perimeter of shapes.
Science	This term in Science, the children will be beginning a new topic forces. We will look at how magnets behave towards each other and consider what magnetic poles are. We will also explore materials that are magnetic and consider how we can show materials are magnetic.
Geography	In Geography this term, the children will be learning about Villages, Towns and Cities. We will explore where people live our planet and consider why some places are sparsely populated and others densely populated. We will consider what affects where people live and what are positive and negative factors that affect a settlement.
DT	During DT week this term we will be making cushions and exploring textiles. We will continue to build on our understanding of DT and follow the processes of research and evaluate existing products, design, make and evaluating the final product.
French	With Mrs Daniel in French this term, we will be recapping greetings and our numbers to 20. We will be moving onto knowing how to say different colours in French and how to tell someone our favourite colour.
Computing	The children will be continuing to develop their Computing skills by exploring emails. We will be using Purple Mash and the software 2Email. We will consider types of communication before looking at how to open and respond to an email. We will learn further skills including how to attach work to an email and how to find an email in an address book.
RE	In R.E, the children will be exploring 'Salvation: Why do Christians call the day Jesus died 'Good Friday?' We will look at the days over Easter and the meaning of each day. We will consider how Christians feel and act on each day.
PE	This term the class will have Forest School. Forest School promotes creativity, confidence and independence. It enables supported risk taking, child-centered learning, exploration and play. In PE the children will be exploring dance and consider how to perform dances using a range of movements.
