Crystal—Term 5

English	This term in English, the children will be exploring their new book 'Rapunzel' by Bethan Woollvin. The children will write a diary entry as Rapunzel to reflect her experiences and viewpoint when she is trapped inside of the tower. They will be utilising their writing skills learnt thus far this year, including adjectives, verbs, adverbs, and emotive language. The children will also be writing a retelling of the fairy tale using all of their writing skills.
Maths	This term the children will be learning about fractions in both shape and number. They will continue to learn about halves and quarters. They will also begin to think about thirds. The key words for this section are equivalence, denominator, numerator, and number line. Towards the end of the term we will begin learning how to tell the time. They will progress from telling the time to o'clock and half past, to learning to read the time to five minutes, including quarter past and quarter to.
Science	This term in Science, the children will be beginning the topic 'Plants ready, steady, grow!' They will find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy. We will also explore that some plants can grow hydroponically, without soil.
Geography	This term in Geography, the children will be learning to compare countries in the UK. Within this topic, they will learn the four UK capital cities, the countries of the UK and how to recognise their shapes, and similarities and differences between a capital city and the place where you live.
Art	In art this term, the children will be learning about primary and secondary colours, colour mixing, and creating textures using different tools. We will be covering collage techniques, experimenting with materials and evaluating our artistic choices, developing the children's understanding of colour, texture, and composition in art.
Music	In music this term, the children will learn to sing, play and follow instructions to perform as a group. They will describe music using simple musical vocabulary, explore multiple ways of making the same sound, describe how they have adapted a sound using musical vocabulary and contribute musically to a final performance.
Computing	The children will develop their computing skills by learning how to make music digitally using 2Sequence. They will explore, edit and combine sounds and think about how music can be used to express feelings and create tunes which depict feelings.
RE	In R.E, we are learning about Islam and what it is to be a Muslim. We will be discussing Allah, the Prophet Muhammad, the Quran and Mosques. To further develop the children's understanding, we will be visiting a Mosque.
PE	This term in Forest school, the children will be developing a range of skills promoting collaboration, resilience and challenge. They will explore their senses and independently make choices around their outdoor learning. We will also be harnessing our cooperation and team strategy skills in outdoor games.
