

Amethyst — Term 5

English	This term in English, the children will be exploring their new book Suffragette; The Battle for Equality by David Roberts. We will discuss the Suffragette movement and particular stories from this time. The children will be producing narrative writing, biographies and speeches as part of our studies.
Maths	The children will be learning about shape and position and direction. This will involve looking at angles and how to calculate angles in shapes. We will then look at four quadrants and shapes with co-ordinates within all four quadrants. This will involve translating and rotating shapes.
Science	The children will be beginning a new topic: 'Animals.' They will studying about the circulatory system and thinking about how bodies can be kept healthy. This will also involve looking at different nutrients and their impact on the human body.
History	In History this term, the children will be learning about Local History. This will involve studying the local area and a study over time tracing how several aspects of national history are reflected in our local area.
Art/DT	This term in Art the children will be looking at 'Craft and Design; Photo opportunity' as their topic. This will involve studying and completing their own Photomontages, before looking in detail at Macro photography, digital art and recreating paintings.
PSHE	The children will be studying the topic of 'Safety and the Changing Body.' This will involve understanding the risks of alcohol, the impact and affects of social media and some of the physical and emotional changes of puberty.
Computing	The children will be continuing to develop their Computing skills by using Purple Mash to study the topic of 'Spreadsheets'. This will involve the children understanding how to use formula wizards. We will be using a spread-sheet to plan pocket money spending before then planning a school event using the spreadsheet programme.
RE	In R.E, the children will be learning about whether it is better to express your beliefs in arts and architecture or in charity and generosity. This will involve the children studying different religions and how they express their faiths in different ways, before evaluating their own viewpoints on this.
PE	This term in P.E, the children will be taking part in tennis and athletics. This will involve learning about different techniques and shot selections in tennis, using these skills to build up to games and competitive matches. The children will learn many different athletics events, including sprinting, the different jumps and some throwing techniques.
