Which promises could you choose to live by?

The parable of the mustard seed Matthew chapter 13 verse 31-32 The Order of the Mustard Seed are a group of Christians who had three promises that they lived their lives by, being true to Christ, to be kind to others and to take the gospel (Good News) to the nations. This week the children have been reflecting on these promises and if they could live their life by one promise, what would it be.
