We are so proud of St. Edmund's Church of England Primary School and the progress we are continuing to make each year. We strive to create the best possible learning environment for our children and would like to invite parents to make a voluntary contribution to the School Fund.

This vital fund supports our work in many ways. It will enable us to provide an education for the children which goes beyond the core curriculum and provides your child with additional opportunities.
