RE: Y6 Residential to Stubbers Adventure Centre – 09.06.25 to 11.06.25

I am very pleased to inform you that we have secured a really exciting residential trip for our Y6 children to commemorate their time with us at St. Edmund's. This will take place at Stubbers Adventure Centre in Upminster, Essex.

The trip will provide exciting and challenging activities, run by experienced and qualified professionals. From activities such as kayaking, canoeing, archery, leap of faith and laser tag, there is bound to be something for everyone! The children will also have the opportunity to share activities with other children from our Federation, who will also be attending. The focus of the weekend will be on building teamwork skills and confidence; to take risks and persevere when faced with challenges and to help prepare the children for their next steps into secondary school.

We will leave St. Edmund's on **Monday 9th June 2025** and return on **Wednesday 11th June 2025** travelling by school mini-bus. We will of course let you know timings closer to the departure date.

The cost of the trip will be £245 which includes all activities, food and travel. We are **asking for a £45 non-refundable deposit, to be paid by Friday 31st January 2025**. This can be paid all at once, or in smaller increments via Schoolcomms, under the payment of Y6 Stubbers. The minimum amount is £5 per payment, with a reducing balance. **The final £200 will be required by Friday 16th May 2025**.
