Crystal—Term 1

English	This term in English, we are beginning a new book called <i>Leaf</i> . With a focus on handwriting the pupils will be writing a narrative retelling a part of the story in their own words. We will be focusing on sentence structure, up levelling their adjectives. We will then write persuasive letters, in character, focusing on using a range of conjunctions.
Maths	This term in maths, we will be learning about place value—counting in steps of 2, 3, and 5 from 0, and in tens, recognising the place value of each digit in a two-digit number (tens, ones), identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations, compare and order numbers from 0 up to 100, read and write numbers to at least 100.
Science	This term in Science, we will be learning about healthy animals including humans. They will understand that exercise makes the heart work harder and is an essential part of a healthy lifestyle. We will also be visiting Pizza Express where the pupils will create and eat their own pizzas, considering what makes a balanced diet!
Geography	This term in geography, the pupils will be learning about hot and cold places. They will explore how hot and cold places are different, where hot and cold places are around the world, how temperature effects hot and cold places and what features an animal needs to live in a hot/cold place.
Art	In art this term, the pupils will develop their ability to tell a story through drawing, creating textures, observational drawing, character expression, and storytelling through illustrations, enhancing their mark-making techniques, observational skills, and imagination in art.
Music	In music, the pupils will use instruments to represent animals, copying rhythms and create call and response rhythms. They will learn to use dynamics to create sound; play in time with a group and experiment with different sounds using the same instrument.
PSHE	In PSHE this term, the pupils are learning about family and relationships. They will explore that families are composed of different people who offer each other care and support and how other people show their feelings and how to respond to them. We will look at the conventions of manners and develop an understanding of self-respect.
RE	In R.E, we are learning about the Creation story and will retell the story of creation from Genesis 1:1–2.3 simply, recognise that 'Creation' is the beginning of the 'big story' of the Bible and say what the story tells Christians about God, Creation and the world.
PE	This term in PE, the pupils will learning ball skills and tag rugby with Miss Bracken on a Tuesday afternoons.
