

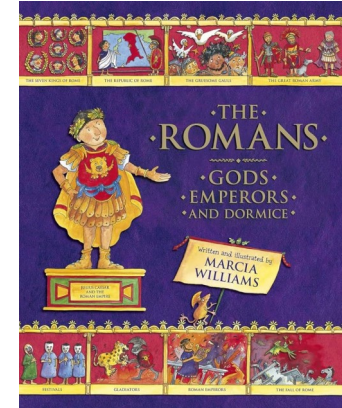

Diamond —Term 1

English	This term in English, the pupils will be exploring their new book, ‘The Romans, Gods, Emperors and Dormice’ by Marcia Williams. The story will immerse the children in the life of the Romans expanding their knowledge and understanding of the time period. They will be writing for a range of purposes, starting with a diary entry.
Maths	This term we will be learning about ‘Place Value’. We will be learning how to represent numbers up to 1,000 in a variety of ways, counting up on a number line and partitioning. We will then be moving onto ‘Addition and Subtraction’, learning how to add and subtract 4-digit numbers whilst exchanging.
Science	This term in Science, the pupils will be beginning a new topic: ‘Electricity’ They will learn about how to create a working circuit using a range of items such as a bulb, buzzer and a switch. The pupils will also learn how to represent different electrical components in circuit drawings.
History	In History this term, the pupils will be learning about the ‘Romans’. We will be looking at how the Romans invaded Britain; what their best battle technique was and their infrastructural successes, building roads, sewers and under-floor heating.
RE	In R.E, we will be exploring what Christians learn from the creation story, by the end of this term pupils are expected to be able to place the concepts of God and Creation on a timeline and make clear links between Genesis 1 and what Christians believe about God and Creation.
PSHE	The pupils will be learning about ‘family and relationships’. The pupils will be looking at respect, how to create healthy relationships and families in the wider world. They will be exploring stereotypes in fictional characters, considering how these influence our ideas about gender and disability.
Computing	Computing this term will be ‘Coding.’ Before moving onto our coding module, we will start with a recap on how to be safe online, looking at how to report an issue and how to know we are on safe websites. We will then in our coding lessons be learning how to use commands in the form of code blocks to make an object move.
PE	This term in P.E, the pupils will be doing swimming and tag rugby. They will be taught that there are different styles of swimming following on from last year. They will learn front crawl, breast stroke and back stroke. In tag rugby they will learn to the art of marking, defending the space they are in and dodging the opposition effectively.
Swimming	This term in Swimming, the pupils will be starting their series of swimming lessons. They will be taught how to stay safe in the water and will develop confidence through practicing key skills. They will learn front crawl, back stroke and how to float, building on their previous experiences to become more independent swimmers.
