Diamond — Term 2

English	This term in English, the pupils will be exploring their new book, ‘Tales Told in Tents’ by Sally Pomme Clayton. This book tells the little known myths and fairytales from Central Asia. They will be writing for a range of purposes, including a setting description and narrative writing.
Maths	This term we will be learning about ‘Multiplication and Division’. We will be learning the multiples of 3, 6, 7, 9, 11 and 12. We will be looking how to divide a number by 1 and itself and how to multiply three numbers together. The pupils will also keep focusing on their times table practice in preparation for the times table test.
Science	This term in Science, the pupils will be beginning a new topic: ‘States of Matter’. They will learn about the three states of matter, solids, liquids and gases. We will look at how things change between these states and how to speed up evaporation.
Geography	In Geography this term, the pupils will be learning about ‘Migration. In this topic we will be looking at which continents have the most emigrants and immigrants, the different types of migration and the advantages of migration for other countries.
French	In French we will be starting a new topic ‘Les fruits et les legumes’. In this unit the pupils will learn 10 new fruits and vegetables before being introduced to simple opinions such as ‘I like’ and ‘I do not like’. The pupils will then learn the basic language needed to buy different quantities of fruit and vegetables from a market stall.
PSHE	The pupils will be learning about ‘Safety and the changing body’. We will be looking at why there are legal age restrictions and how quickly information can spread on the internet. We will also be looking at what it means to grow up, physical changes as well as things they will be able to do such as learning to drive and having a job.
Art	In art this term we will developing our drawing skills, we will be looking at how to shade and create simple 3D effects, how to use charcoal and rubber to show areas of light and dark in drawings, as well as how to demonstrate an awareness of the relative size of the objects they draw.
RE	In R.E, we will be exploring what Christians learning about Incarnation. We will be digging deeper into our title ‘What is the Trinity?’ and finding out why this is important to Christians. The pupils will be exploring the central belief that God is one being that exists in three distinct persons: the Father, the Sun and the Holy Spirit.
PE	This term in P.E, the children will be doing swimming and Orienteering. So far the children’s swimming abilities have grown massively, hopefully by the end of term pupils will have the opportunity to swim with their clothes on building up their survival skills.
