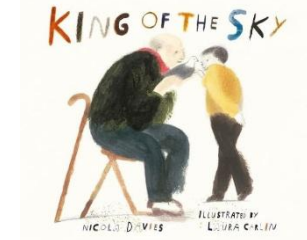

Emerald—Term 2

English	This term the pupils will be reading, 'King of the Sky.' They will be exploring some of the key themes of the book in both English and Destination Reader lessons. As part of their studies, the pupils will produce different writing, such as non-chronological reports, setting descriptions and narrative writing.
Maths	The pupils will be looking at multiplication and division, before then beginning work on fractions. This will include understanding square, cube and prime numbers. As part of their studies on fractions, the pupils will learn about equivalent fractions, mixed and improper fractions and comparing and ordering them.
Science	This term the pupils will be continuing to study the topic of, 'Materials.' This will involve the pupils using their knowledge of solids, liquids and gases to decide how mixtures might be separated. They will also be learning about and exploring how some materials dissolve in liquids to form solutions.
Geography	In Geography this term, the pupils will be learning about the Energy and Sustainability. This will involve learning about what sustainability is and whether fossil fuels are sustainable in the future. The pupils will also look at case studies of places around the world and what measures they have taken.
Computing	This term the pupils will be learning more about Online Safety before then learning about databases. This will involve the children understanding different ways in which they can stay safe online. When starting this topic, the pupils will understand what they are before having the opportunity to create their own databases.
PSHE	In PSHE the children will be learning about safety and the changing body. This will involve the pupils learning about ways to manage stress, the importance of rest and how to care for themselves.
Music	This term the will be learning about musical theatre. They will be learning how singing, acting and dancing are combined to create an overall performance.
RE	In R.E, the pupils will be exploring the question, 'Was Jesus the Messiah?' This will involve the pupils thinking about what Christians believe happened to Jesus, before beginning to discuss their own thoughts on this.
PE	This term in P.E, the pupils will have two PE sessions a week. This will include netball and orienteering. This will involve improving their skills for netball before applying them to match scenarios. Orienteering will involve the pupils competing in various challenges outdoors and improving their knowledge of how to compete in these.
