Amethyst — Term 2

English	After completing Treason and writing an extended narrative we will be looking at a KS2 picture book called 'The Viewer'. Pupils will have opportunities to explore the images and write detailed descriptions as well as researching and writing a non-chronological report on a period in history.
Maths	This term the pupils will further their understanding of fractions and decimals. They will learn to add, subtract, multiply and divide fractions and decimals and express fractions in their simplest forms, before applying their understanding to reasoning and problem solving.
Science	The pupils will be taught to recognize that light appears to in straight lines and use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain that objects are seen to give out or reflect light into the eye and to explain why shadows have the same shape as the objects that cast them.
Geography	In Geography this term, the pupils will be studying a unit on Population. They will learn about where people are located globally and within the UK. They will look at the challenges facing our increasing and ageing population and what can be done to ensure the planet's resources will benefit all.
RE	This term the pupils will look at the questions 'What would Jesus Do?' They will explore Bible stories from the four Gospels and discuss how to apply these messages to our own lives.
French	In French we will be learning the vocabulary needed at The Tea Rooms. Pupils will learn to order typical French foods and drinks, as well as the numbers needed for prices.
Art	The pupils will be studying a variety of artists this term including works by David Hockney, Frank Bowling and Lubaina Himid then use their ideas as inspiration for their own piece of artwork.
DT	During DT week the pupils will be designing and create a working model of their own playgrounds.
PE	This term in P.E, the pupils will be working on their Orienteering skills with Miss Bracken and hand ball skills, including netball.
