| English | This term in English, the pupils will be exploring their new book <i>Now or Never</i> by Bali Rai. We will discuss the complex themes in the story and learn about life as a soldier in WW2. Our writing will be inspired by the text and we will be writing diary entries and a newspaper report. |
| Maths | The pupils will be continuing to practice their calculating skills. They will be consolidating work on multiplying and dividing fractions and learning to find fractions of amounts. We will also be working with decimals and percentages and looking at ratio. |
| Science | The pupils will be beginning a new topic: 'Evolution.' They will recognise fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the Earth millions of years ago. They'll identify how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment in different ways and that adaptation may lead to evolution. |
| History | In History this term, the pupils will be learning about 20th Century Conflicts. They will find out why the First World War began, what it was like in the trenches and how Hitler rose to power. Ultimately, the children will decide if World War 2 could have been avoided. |
| PSHE | In PSHE, we will be exploring Economic wellbeing understanding how to safeguard money in both digital and physical environments, understand the risks of gambling and explain how careers function in different settings and the roles of responsibilities that come with them. |
| Music | The pupils will appraise the work of Mendelssohn and further develop improvisation and composition skills. They will follow or lead as a conductor and create a graphic score to represent sounds. Using teamwork they will create a group composition featuring changes in texture, dynamics and pitch. |
| Computing | The pupils will be continuing to develop their Computing skills by using Purple Mash to code. They will design a playable game with a timer and a score. They will plan and use selection and variables and understand how the launch command works. |
| RE | In R.E, the pupils will be learning 'What does it mean to be Muslim in Britain today?' They will learn in depth about the five pillars of Islam and the importance of them to Muslim believers. They will also learn about the Qur'an and why this religious text is so important to Muslims. |
| PE | This term in P.E, the pupils will be performing gymnastics with Miss Bracken. They will be exploring travelling in different ways, using apparatus effectively and sequencing moves. Mr Godoy will be teaching Hockey, teaching the pupils key fundamental skills of passing, dribbling, shooting and tackling. |
